


7. Sew the long edge of a small white half-square triangle to the aqua diamond on the end of each segment from steps 5 and 6. Press the seam allowances in the same direction as the diamonds on each segment.



8. Align the long edge of a large white half-square triangle with the long edge of a four-diamond segment, positioning the segments so that a small tip of the large white triangle is exposed. The point of the V formed should be  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge. The white triangle is oversized, so it will be longer than the diamond strip. Pin and then sew the strip to the triangle. Press the seam allowances open. Repeat to make a total of eight units.



9. Align a five-diamond segment along the side adjacent to the four-diamond segment of a unit from step 8, positioning it so that a small tip of the light-red diamond hangs over the end. The point of the V formed should be  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge. Pin and then sew the strip in place. Press the seam allowances open. Repeat to make a total of eight units.



10. Use your ruler and a rotary cutter to trim off the excess of the large white triangle from each unit from step 9, trimming it even with the small white triangles.
