MATERIALS

Yardage is based on 42"-wide fabric.

2 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards of light floral for blocks

1 yard of black floral for blocks

1 yard of multicolored print for blocks

1 yard of red print for blocks

1 yard of large geometric print for blocks

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard of red stripe for binding

4 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards of fabric for backing

67" x 85" piece of batting

CUTTING

From each of the black floral, multicolored print, and red print, cut:

3 strips, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" (9 total)

2 strips, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"; crosscut into 8 squares, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (24 total)

From the large geometric print, cut:

3 strips, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"

2 strips, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"; crosscut into 7 squares, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the light floral, cut:



27 strips, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"; crosscut 12 of the strips into 124 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the red stripe, cut:

8 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"

MAKING THE BLOCKS


1 Using the "Quick Corners" method on page 6, make 31 Snowball blocks by sewing a light-floral 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each corner of the print 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Press the seam allowances toward the triangles.




2 Referring to "Strip Piecing" on page 5, use the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" print strips to make three strip sets in each of the following combinations:

- ▶ Set A: black floral, light floral, multicolored
- ▶ Set B: light floral, red print, light floral
- ▶ Set C: light floral, geometric print, light floral

Press the seam allowances away from the light-floral strips in each strip set. Crosscut each group (A, B, and C) into 32 units, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, for a total of 96 units.
