

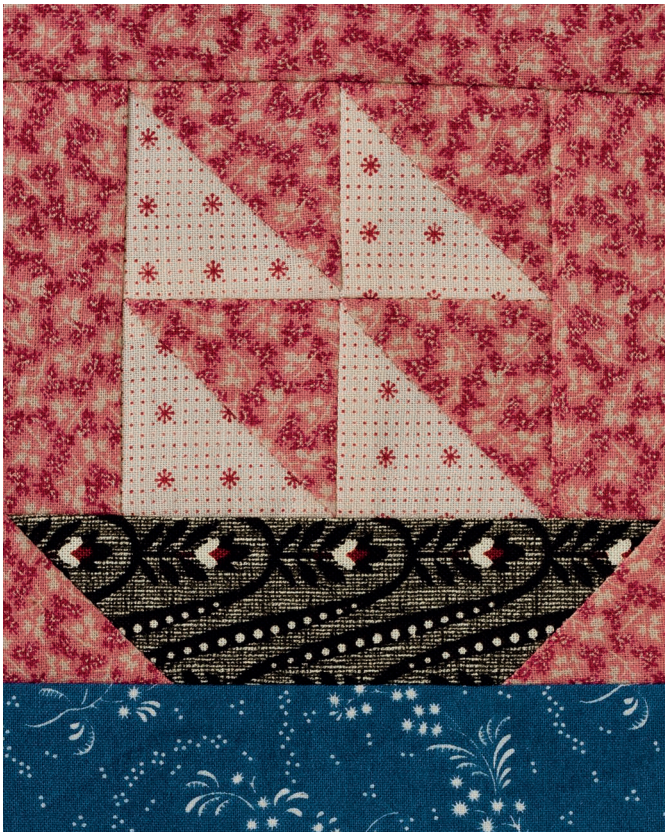


We goofed.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

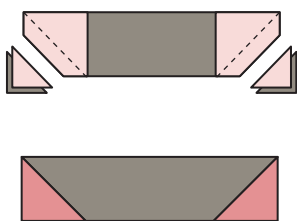
- **A:** 1 black rectangle, $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$
- **B:** 2 pink squares, $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$
- **C:** 2 pink squares, $2\frac{1}{8}'' \times 2\frac{1}{8}''$; cut the squares in half diagonally to yield 4 triangles
- **D:** 2 pink rectangles, $1\frac{1}{4}'' \times 3''$
- **E:** 1 pink rectangle, $1'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$
- **F:** 2 light squares, $2\frac{1}{8}'' \times 2\frac{1}{8}''$; cut the squares in half diagonally to yield 4 triangles
- **G:** 1 blue rectangle, $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$

ASSEMBLY

Press the seam allowances open after sewing each seam unless directed otherwise.

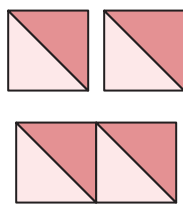
1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each B square. Referring to "Stitch-and-Flip Corners" on page 192, join a marked B square to each end of the A rectangle (*fig. 1*).
2. Referring to "Half-Square-Triangle Units" on page 192, sew the C and F triangles together in pairs to make four half-square-triangle units measuring $1\frac{3}{4}''$ square. Press the seam allowances toward the C triangles. Arrange the half-square-triangle units as shown. Sew the units together into two rows, and then join the rows (*fig. 2*).
3. Sew the D rectangles to opposite sides of the step 2 unit (*fig. 3*).
4. Arrange the E rectangle, the units from steps 1 and 3, and the G rectangle (*fig. 4*). Join the pieces.

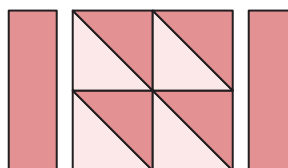
Make 1 unit,

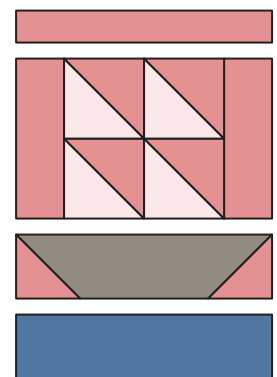
Make 1 unit,

Above is a layout key for The Sparrow's Window, opposite. The numbers correspond to the 182 blocks in this book. Each vertical row contains 14 blocks, one half block that finishes to 2" x 4" (made with eight half-square-triangle units that finish to 1"), and 14 sashing rectangles. Sashing strips separate the rows; the quilt is framed with inner, middle, and outer borders.

To make the quilt shown, stitch 182 blocks and 13 half blocks, and then cut the following pieces for sashing and borders:

- + 182 blue sashing rectangles, 1½" x 4½"
- + 14 blue sashing strips, 1½" x 86½"
- + 2 blue inner-border strips (top and bottom edges), 1½" x 66½"
- + 2 navy middle-border strips (side edges), 1" x 88½"
- + 2 navy middle-border strips (top and bottom edges), 1" x 67½"
- + 2 blue outer-border strips (side edges), 5½" x 89½"
- + 2 blue outer-border strips (top and bottom edges), 3½" x 77½"
