Sister's Choice TABLE TOPPER

The octagon shape of this easy table topper lends a fun twist to the classic Sister's Choice block—a simple and versatile design that looks equally compelling in modern prints, bright solids, or reproduction fabrics. This speedy project requires only one big block, so you might be able to finish it in time to decorate your table tonight!

FINISHED SIZE: 16½" × 16½"

MATERIALS

Yardage is based on 42"-wide fabric. A fat quarter measures 18" × 21".

1 fat quarter of white solid for background
¾ yard of navy dot for block and binding
⅛ yard each of navy floral and aqua print for block
¾ yard of fabric for backing
21" × 21" square of batting

CUTTING

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances.

From the white solid, cut:

1 square, 5½" × 5½"; cut into quarters diagonally to yield 4 triangles

4 squares, 3⅞" × 3⅞"

4 squares, 3½" × 3½"

4 strips, 1" × 12"

4 strips, 1" × 7"

From the navy dot, cut:

2 squares, 3⅞" × 3⅞"

2 squares, 3½" × 3½"

2 strips, 2½" × 42"

From the navy floral, cut:

2 squares, 3⅞" × 3⅞"

2 squares, 3½" × 3½"

From the aqua print, cut:

5 squares, 3½" × 3½"
