R19–33: Sc 40.

R34: *Sc 6, dec 1*, rep 5 times. (35 sts)

R35: *Sc 5, dec 1*, rep 5 times. (30 sts)

R36 and 37: Sc 30.

R38: *Sc 4, dec 1*, rep 5 times. (25 sts)

R39 and 40: Sc 25.

R41: *Sc 3, dec 1*, rep 5 times. (20 sts)

Stuff almost to top.

R42: *Sc 2, dec 1*, rep 5 times. (15 sts)

R43: *Sc 1, dec 1*, rep 5 times. (10 sts)

Finish stuffing.

R44: *Sk 1 sc, sc 1*, rep 5 times. (5 sts)

Fasten off, leaving long tail to close up the 5-st hole, and weave in end.

SIDE WINGS

Make 2.

Using red yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 8 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (16 sts)

R3–15: Sc 16.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Stuff lightly and sew to each side of plane.

TAIL

Using red yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (14 sts)

R3–8: Sc 14.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Stuff lightly and sew to back of plane.

BACK WINGS

Make 2.

Using red yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

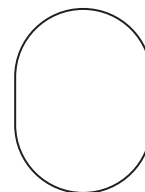
R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3–8: Sc 12.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Stuff lightly and sew to each side at back of plane, below tail.

FINISHING

Cut out little pieces of white felt for windows and sew or glue to airplane's body.

TOYS in Pajamas (BUNNY, BEAR, KOALA)

I love kids in footed pajamas! The cutest pictures of the girls are of them with their footed pajamas on, looking all sleepy and cuddly. What's cuter than little kids in pajamas? Softies in pajamas, of course, with their very own little good-night toys.

FINISHED SIZES

Big Toys: Approx 9" tall

Little Toys: Approx 4" tall

MATERIALS

Worsted-weight yarn in red, white, gray, pink, brown, and yellow

G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook

6, 9, or 12 mm plastic eyes with safety backings

Small pieces of black, white, pink, and tan craft felt

Sewing thread and sharp needle

Black and pink embroidery floss and tapestry needle

Small buttons for pajamas (optional)

Fiberfill or stuffing of your choice

BIG TOYS

HEAD

Using white, brown, or gray yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (24 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (30 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (36 sts)

R7: *Sc 5, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (42 sts)

R8: *Sc 6, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (48 sts)

R9–20: Sc 48.

R21: *Sc 6, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (42 sts)

R22: *Sc 5, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (36 sts)

R23: *Sc 4, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (30 sts)

R24: *Sc 3, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (24 sts)

R25: Sc 24.

Work on face: For all, position and attach 9 mm eyes. For bunny or bear, cut a piece of white or tan felt, embroider nose and mouth, and sew to face. For koala, cut a piece of black felt for nose, sew to face, and embroider mouth.

R26: *Sc 2, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (18 sts)

R27: Sc 18.

Stuff head firmly.

R28: *Sc 1, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (12 sts)

R29: *Sk 1 sc, sc 1*, rep 6 times. (6 sts)

Fasten off and weave in end.

BODY

Use preferred yarn color for pajamas.

If desired, work rnds 13–16 in white for stripe on koala pajamas.

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (24 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (30 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (36 sts)

R7–14: Sc 36.

R15: *Sc 4, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (30 sts)

R16–21: Sc 30.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Stuff and sew to head. Sew two little buttons to pajamas if you wish—they look cute.

HOOD FOR BEAR

Using yarn color to match pajamas,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each st around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times. (24 sts)

LEGS

Make 2.

Using skin-colored yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(24 sts)

R5 and 6: Hdc 12, sc 12.

R7: *Sc 2, dec 1*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R8: *Sc 1, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (12 sts)

R9–20: Sc 12, stuffing as you go.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Sew to body.

DIAPER

Using white yarn and working back and forth,

Loosely ch 31.

Row 1: Sc 30, starting in second ch from hook, turn.

Rows 2–7: Ch 1, sc 30, turn.

Row 8: Sl st 10, sc 10, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc 10, turn.

Row 10: Sk 1 sc, sc 7, sk 1 sc, sc 1, turn.
(8 sts)

Row 11: Sk 1, sc 5, sk 1 sc, sc 1, turn.
(6 sts)

Row 12: Sk 1, sc 3, sk 1 sc, sc 1, turn.
(4 sts)

Row 13–16: Ch 1, sc 4, turn.

Row 17: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc 2, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (6 sts)

Row 18: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc 4, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (8 sts)

Row 19: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc 6, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (10 sts)

Row 20: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc 8, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (12 sts)

Row 21: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc 10, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (14 sts)

Row 22: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc 12, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (16 sts)

Rows 23–26: Ch 1, sc 16, turn.

Fasten off and weave in end.

Attach Velcro pieces at each end of WS on longer piece and at each end of RS on shorter piece (see photo at left).

HAT

Using white yarn and a size 7 hook,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(24 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(30 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(36 sts)

R7: *Sc 5, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(42 sts)

R8–16: Sc 42.

Fasten off and weave in end.



R4: Sc 7, stuffing as you go.

R5–9: Sc 7.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Stuff lightly, sew open end of arms tog and sew to body; sew legs to body.

LITTLE SKIRT FOR GIRL

Using white yarn,

Holding doll upside down (legs up in the air), join yarn at back to one of the front loops you left in R9 when making body.

R1: Sc 20 through front loops all around body.

R2: Sc 2 in every sc. (40 sts)

R3 and 4: Sc 40.

Fasten off and weave in end.



HAT FOR BOY

Using the desired yarn color for hat,

R1: Ch 2, 5 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (10 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 5 times. (15 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 5 times. (20 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 5 times. (25 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 5 times. (30 sts)

R7: *Sc 5, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 5 times. (35 sts)

R8–14: Sc 35.

Fasten off and weave in end.

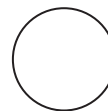
Ear flaps (make 2): Ch 3, dc 6 in third ch from hook. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing. Sew flaps to each side of hat where ears would be.



FINISHING

Cut a piece of brown yarn about 8" long.

Sew the strand of yarn in and out of the sts at the top of the head to form loops for hair.



Doll cheek

R16: *Sc 2, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (18 sts)

R17: *Sc 1, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (12 sts)
Stuff.

R18: *Sk 1 sc, sc 1*, rep 6 times. (6 sts)
Fasten off and weave in end.

EARS

Make 2.

Using tan yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 5 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 5.

R3: Sc 2 in each sc around. (10 sts)

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Sew to head.

BODY

Using tan yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R4–12: Sc 18.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Stuff and sew to head.

ARMS

Make 2.

Using tan yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2–5: Sc 6.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Sew open end tog and sew to body.

TAIL

Using brown yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts)

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R4–16: Sc 18.

R17: *Sc 1, dec 1*, rep 6 times. (12 sts)

R18 and 19: Sc 12.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Stuff tail lightly, sew open end tog,
and sew to body.

LEGS

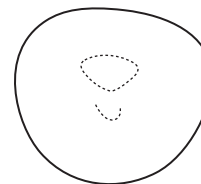
Make 2.

Using brown yarn,

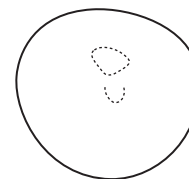
R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2–8: Sc 6.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Sew open end tog and sew to body.

LID

Using yellow yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around (12 sts).

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(24 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(30 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(36 sts)

R7: *Sc 5, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(42 sts)

R8: *Sc 6, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(48 sts)

R9–13: Sc 48.

Fasten off and weave in end.

KNOB ON LID

Using blue yarn, work as for knob on teapot lid on page 69.

CUP AND SAUCER**CUP**

Using blue yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts).

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(24 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(30 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(36 sts)

R7: *Sc 5, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(42 sts)



R8: *Sc 6, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(48 sts)

R9–13: Sc 48.

Change to yellow yarn.

R14: Sc 48.

Change to blue yarn.

R15: Sc 48.

Change to yellow yarn.

R16: Sc 48.

Change to blue yarn.

R17–19: Sc 48.

Fasten off and weave in end.

HANDLE

Using blue yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 5 sc in second ch from hook.

R2–12: Sc 5.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.
Sew to cup.

SAUCER

Using yellow yarn,

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook.

R2: Sc 2 in each sc around. (12 sts).

R3: *Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(18 sts)

R4: *Sc 2, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(24 sts)

R5: *Sc 3, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(30 sts)

R6: *Sc 4, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(36 sts)

R7: *Sc 5, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(42 sts)

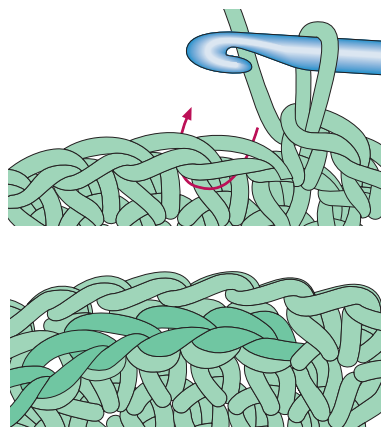
R8: *Sc 6, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(48 sts)

R9: *Sc 7, 2 sc in next sc*, rep 6 times.
(54 sts)

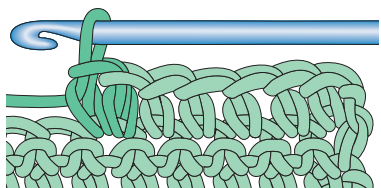
R10 and 11: Sc 54.

Fasten off and weave in end.

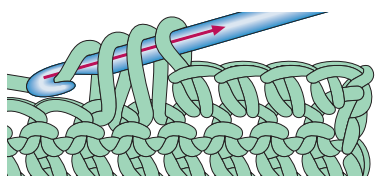
Back Post Single Crochet (BPsc): Insert the hook from the back around the vertical section, or post, of the single crochet stitch in the previous row, and complete the single crochet stitch as usual. Repeat as directed to get nice, slightly raised, braid-like row of stitches.



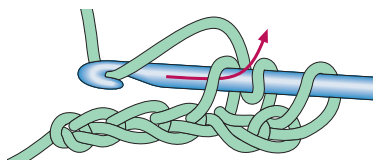
Single Crochet Increase: Work two single crochet stitches into the same stitch.



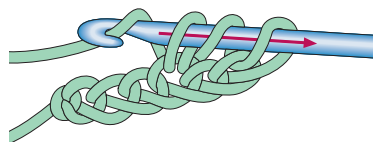
Single Crochet Decrease (dec): (Insert the hook into the next stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop) twice; yarn over and pull through all three loops on the hook.



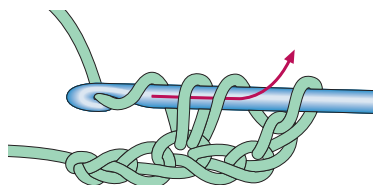
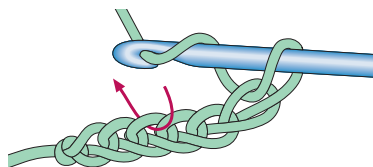
Half Double Crochet (hdc): *Yarn over the hook, insert the hook into the chain or stitch indicated. Yarn over the hook and pull through the stitch (three loops remain on the hook).



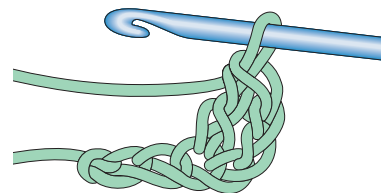
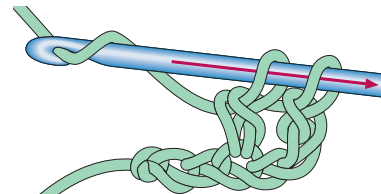
Yarn over the hook and pull through all three loops on the hook. Repeat from * for the required number of stitches.



Double Crochet (dc): *Yarn over the hook, insert the hook into the chain or stitch indicated. Yarn over the hook and pull through the stitch (three loops are on the hook); yarn over the hook and pull through two loops on the hook (two loops remain on the hook).



Yarn over the hook and pull through the remaining two loops on the hook (one loop remains on the hook). Repeat from * for the required number of stitches.



Triple Crochet (tr): *Yarn over the hook twice, insert the hook into the chain or stitch indicated. Yarn over the hook and pull through the stitch (four loops on the hook); yarn over the hook and pull through two loops on the hook (three loops remain on the hook).
